



Dear Parents/Guardians,

It certainly has been a pleasure to be Christ the King's School Nurse this year. It has been very rewarding to work with you, the children, faculty and staff.

As the year winds down, there are some Housekeeping details in the clinic to address.

1. If your child has medication that needs to be picked up, please do so, **in person**, prior to or on the last day of school: May 26th. NO medication will be sent home with the child.

2. If you anticipate that your child will need medication during the 2017-2018 school year next year, please let me know and I will send home the forms prior to the last day of school. **THIS INCLUDES: PAIN RELIEVERS (ACETAMINOPHEN, IBUPROFEN), SELF-CARRY ALBUTEROL/RESCUE INHALERS, EPI-PENS, BENADRYL AND PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS ETC...**

The form will need to be signed by you, the parent/guardian AND the child's physician, specialist, dentist, or orthodontist.

3. If you have a child entering Kindergarten and/or Seventh grade, they will need to have additional immunizations as required by the Ohio Department of Health. Your child's physician will provide you with the necessary documentation needed for their health file at school. If they already have their shots completed, please have the physician FAX the shot record to my attention at 419-475-4050.

4. If there is a change in your child's health, new immunizations, new medications, or conditions I may need to be aware of, please do not hesitate to call, email or drop off medical information to the school office. I will always treat each child with confidentiality and respect.

5. Lastly, I want to wish all of you a very healthy, happy and safe summer!
