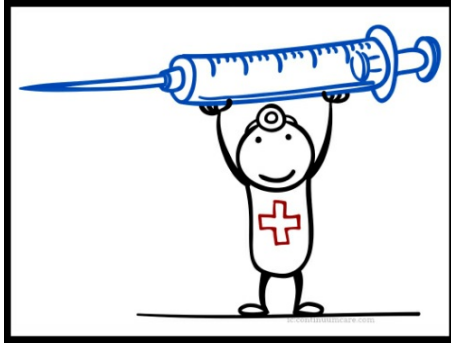


Principal's Newsletter

clinic, presented by Heath Heroes, here at
Christ the King for the children. It is a free
vaccine program throughout the United
States.

This will be the *injection vaccine* NOT the
FluMist, as it is no longer available.

This week we are sending home in the family newsletter envelope, an Influenza (Flu) Vaccine Consent form for the Health Heroes Flu Vaccine clinic that will be held here at Christ the King on September 8, 2017 from 8am-12:00pm in the Activities Building (Gym).

This program is open to all Pre-K 4 through 8th grade students.

If you would like your child(ren) immunized, please complete and send in the consent form by September 6th. If you choose not to participate in this free vaccine program, that is perfectly fine... just recycle the paper form!

How much: Vaccines are provided at **NO COST** to students, parents, or schools. We bill both Medicaid and private insurance; however, we never bill students or parents for any out-of-pocket expenses or deductibles. Qualifying uninsured students can be given the vaccine at no charge.

Why: The best way to minimize or avoid the spread of flu is to get an annual flu vaccination. Each year the vaccine protects against new strains, therefore, the vaccine should be administered annually.
