Last evening, we had Lt. Phil Cook from the Toledo Police Department come and give an outstanding presentation to parents about A.L.i.C.E., what it stands for, and what it means for Christ the King. It can be a very difficult topic to wrap our heads around, and is something I pray we never have to use, but it is always good to be prepared.

Lt. Cook made many valid points and provided great conversation starters, and as he mentioned the, training for the kids comes from parents and teachers. I've encouraged the teachers to continue the conversation with the students, but to please make sure it is age-appropriate. We want to assure the kids that school is, above else, a safe place. The younger students just need to be reminded to follow their teacher's lead, while the older students can have the conversation on what they would do in a crisis situation. Our reunification points are Notre Dame Academy and Kohl's Department Store. It is important for parents to remember to go to one of those two locations *instead of coming to school* to allow the emergency personal do their jobs. I have decided, based off the training and conversation with Lt. Cook, that we will not do a full-blown drill or scenarios with the kids. I'm counting on the teachers and parents to continue the training. If there are any further questions or if you want to know what steps we are taking, please do not hesitate to call me or send me an email.


MAP and state testing


WELCOME TO CHRIST THE KING PARISH!
