COLD & FLU SEASON IS UPON US!

Dear Parents and Guardians of children at Christ the King,

We are in Cold and Flu Season...
A few friendly reminders...

Please do not send your child to school if he/she has or as had:

1. Fever of 100 degrees within the last 24 hours (must be fever free without medication)
2. Vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
3. Continuous coughing not relieved with cough medicine

If your child is going to require medication administration here at school, a form must be filled out by you and the prescribing physician. This [form](#) is available to download on the Christ the King website.

As many people are getting colds and some with the flu, we would greatly appreciate your assistance in preventing the spread of germs and illnesses within our school. Please help us in reinforcing to your children good health habits to protect themselves as well as others:

1. Plenty of rest and good nutrition
2. Do not eat or drink from same utensil or container after someone else.
3. Keep hydrated by drinking a lot of fluids. Water bottles may be brought to school.
4. When coughing or sneezing, use your "cough corner" or cover your mouth and nose with a tissue. Proper disposal of tissues and hand sanitizing afterwards.
5. Practice frequent hand washing with soap and water as this is the best way to prevent the spread of germs. (Sing the Happy Birthday song while you wash your hands!)

Since some students may need to be picked up when they become ill at school, we do need current telephone numbers and contact information. Please inform the school office if you have had a change in your information.

Thank you in advance for working with us and being proactive in keeping the students and staff as healthy as possible during this cold and flu season.
